Issuance of no objection certificate in favour of -

The undersigned is directed to refer to his letter no. 338-SC/AIS, dt. 4.10.96 on the above subject and to say that the Govt. in the Education Deptt. has no objection to Modella Caretaker Centre & School, 27 Church Road, Siliguri, receiving its affiliation with C.B.S.E. New Delhi, subject to the following observations and conditions.

1. the State Govt. will not bear any financial liabilities for the school at present or in future.

2. The school will not enhance the tuition fees without the prior approval of the Govt. in writing.

3. 10% of the new admissions in the school each year will be allowed on the recommendations of the School Education Deptt. and 50% of such recommended students shall be allowed to prosecute studies in the school free of any ~~charges~~. charges.

4. The School will pay its teaching and non-teaching staff emoluments at a rate which will not be less than those of their counter parts with equivalent educational qualifications in State aided educational institutions of the state.

5. Violation of any of the conditions laid down in sub-para (3) and sub-para (4) shall entail withdrawal of this no-objection of the State Government with effect from the beginning of the next academic year.

Sub : Change of location of "Medella caretaker  
centre & schools"

Sir,

I have the honour to report that the above named private Educational Institution was issued with a "No objection certificate" vide memo No 691-SE(S) dt, 28.11.96, and accordingly it was affiliated with "Central Board of Secondary Education" with effect from 1.4.99, vide memo. No. CBSE/AFF/24358/99/5368-72 dt, 7.7.99, having the address-" Medella Caretaker Centre & Schools, 27-Church Road, Siliguri, Dist.- Darjeeling.

In the said affiliation order, the School Authority was directed to complete the construction at the new site and to shift the school to the said site (para-21). The new site of the school is located in the address-" Vill-Jatiakali, P.O. Fulbari, G.P.-Fulbari II, under Rajganj Block, P.S.Bhaktinagar, in the district of Jalpaiguri" Again when the School Authority, applied for upgradation of the school, vide *scd no.* CBSE/AFF/24358/2003/4264 dated, 22.11.02, raised the question that the new address of the school differs from that as noted in the No Objection Certificate and directed the school authority to get the NO N.O.C corrected/ modified with permission to shift the school.

On request from the school authority, an inquiry was held on 20.12.02 by Sri P.Das, S.I. of School(SE) and he reported that the school was shifted to the new building constructed in the new site and it is running in the new address as noted in previous para.

Therefore, I recommend the case for according post facto approval towards shifting of the school to the new address for getting recognition of the up-graded section/classes at an early date.
